

CERTIFICATION EXAMINATIONS

ASQ has now transitioned to computer-based test (CBT) delivery for its certification exams, starting with its October exam window. Benefits of CBT include an increased number of test site locations, administrations, and availability of days on which to take exams. Translated exams are expected to be available starting in March 2017.

While the exam experience has changed to CBT, the check-in process at testing locations is similar to the previous pencil and paper exams. Examinees will be required to show identification and will be allowed to bring reference books and certain calculators into the exam.

Exams will no longer be offered by any ASQ Section.

ASQ Re-Certification

When Re-certification is required for your particular ASQ Certificate, (CQT not required), follow the steps below :

1. ASQ Headquarters does not send the Recertification package anymore. ASQ will send you a reminder card approx 3-4 months prior to the expiry date of your certificate, and another reminder will follow prior to 3-4 weeks prior to the expiry date.
2. You can download the Recertification Journal package from the ASQ website. Or, you can also contact the ASQ Headquarters and request to send you the package via snail mail.
3. The Recertification Journal can be downloaded at this link:

4. Complete the package in a timely manner, following the instructions provided in the Journal carefully.

5. Compile copies of all the relevant documents, certifications, course accreditation's and any other appropriate documents you are using to verify your CU's. (Note: Do not include original documents in support of your claim for the RUs).
6. Complete the application and denote method of payment. (Note: payment by credit card is preferred for quick processing).
7. If paying by cheque (bank draft or money order), please include a stamped envelop (8 in x11.5 in) for US postage in the package.
8. [Contact](#) and forward the completed package to the Hamilton Section Certification Chair ([Jeff Race](#)). If you are unable to contact Jeff, please contact the Past Chair ([Kris Krishnamoorthy](#)).
9. Accreditation from ASQ may take about 1 month after submission by the Certification Chair.
