Where: Engineering Technology Building Room 223. (This is the 5 story glass building closest to Main Street)

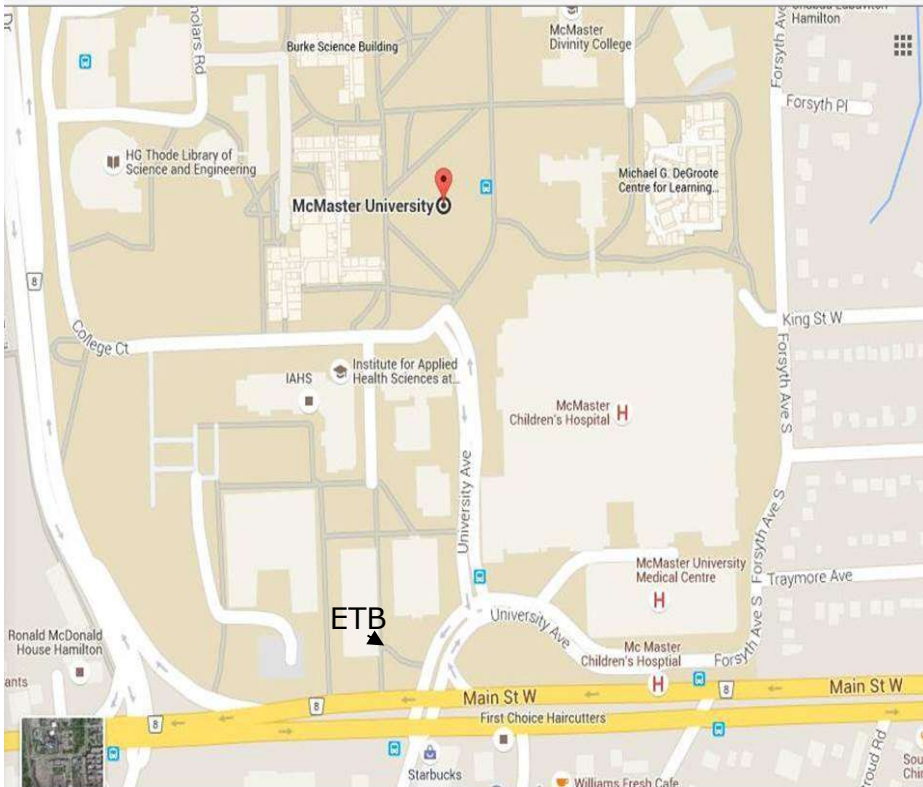
Parking: \$7 flat rate. Closest is lot I. Best entrance to the parking lot is off Cootes Drive.

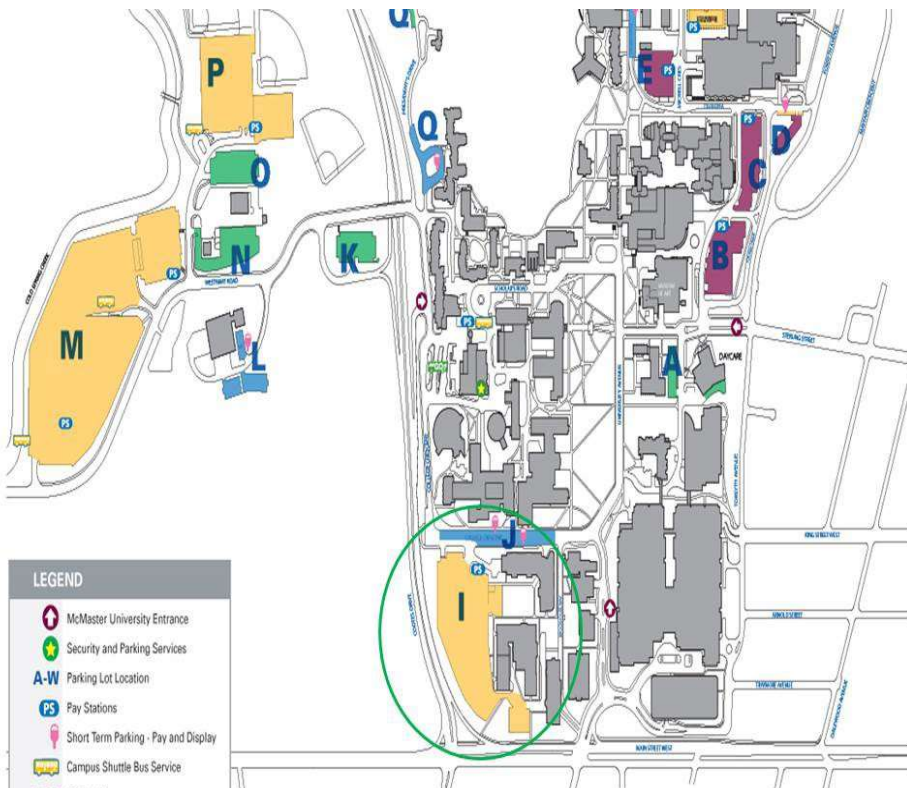


Driving Directions Coming from the west (i.e. Dundas):

Head east on Main St. W. Turn left onto Cootes Dr. Stay right to take the ramp into the university. Turn right on College Court. Follow College Court which will come to an elbow. Take the first right into the parking lot. You will be parking in "LOT I." Once you have parked, walk east toward the Engineering Technology Building (ETB). From the east (i.e. Burlington/Oakville):

Take the 403 W. Exit 69A for ON-8/ Main St. W. Turn left onto Main St. W. Stay right to take Cootes Dr. Stay right to take the ramp into the university. Turn right on College Court. Follow College Court which will come to an elbow. Take the first right into the parking lot. You will be parking in "LOT I."
